# Upward Bound Executive Council: UBEC

## What is UBEC

In order to create a more “college-like” atmosphere for the summer program, we are implementing an executive council, or *student government*, that will be responsible for a variety of tasks throughout the summer program. This will be a group of students in leadership positions who are willing to represent the rest of the Upward Bound students and be accountable to the administration (Leanne & Andy).

Students who are elected to these positions are charged with the responsibility to represent the student body to the Administration of Upward Bound and continue building a better student experience for all who attend this great summer program.

## How can I get Involved

Like the yearbook and newspaper, UBEC will be a job site. There will be 5 openings: All students are welcome to apply for one of 5 positions on the executive council. Applications are due no later than May 31<sup>st</sup>, the first day of the summer program. The top 10 applicants will be able to campaign to the other students attending the summer program. All students will then vote for the best candidates to fill the 5 positions.
