A Fast Track Degree Program

International Early College (IEC) allows you as a student to take college classes at an accredited University, all while attending high school or an equivalent program.

On Campus - Participating on campus, you will take full SUU courses allowing you to work towards a US high school diploma while also working towards your SUU associates degree. In our On Campus program, you will enjoy our HomeStay Housing Program. Here you may live with a local American family who share their culture in a place that feels like home.

Online - Participating online through a partner international high school you will work towards your local high school requirements and take SUU online courses. The credits earned from these courses can be applied to an SUU degree, or can be transferred to other accredited programs around the world. Online courses are delivered in an asynchronous on-line format to maximize flexibility and convenience for students.

English Requirements

TOEFL IBT: 71, IELTS: 6.0, or DUOLINGO: 105

If you do not meet the English proficiency minimums, you may begin in our online Intensive English Program (IEP). You will earn university credits and automatically progress into online early college upon successful completion of our IEP program.

How to Get Started

1. Application - Pay required \$60 Application Fee.

Application Deadlines: **Fall Semester - April 15th**

Spring Semester - October 15th

Summer Semester - February 15th

2. English Proficiency - Provide proof of English proficiency via TOEFL IBT:71, IELTS: 6.0 or DUOLINGO 105 or successful completion of our IEP program.
3. Transcripts - Submit high school transcript(s) demonstrating a 2.0 minimum grade point average (GPA) on a U.S. 4.0 GPA scale.
4. Passport - Provide a copy of the photo page of your passport.
5. Finances - On campus international students are required to demonstrate that they have the ability to fund the duration of their studies at SUU. However, proof that funds are available for the first year of study via an official document from a banking institution will suffice for admission.
