

SOUTHERN UTAH UNIVERSITY PETITION FOR ACADEMIC RENEWAL

An undergraduate student currently enrolled at Southern Utah University may petition for Academic Renewal. This procedure permits the student to request that his/her academic record be reviewed for the purpose of discounting, for cumulative grade point average computation, courses with a D plus or lower grade. These classes must have been entered on the student's academic record five or more calendar years prior to the time of the request for renewal. Under this procedure, credit received for these courses will be cancelled and will not count in meeting any institutional or graduation requirement.

- This renewal option can be used only once during a student's undergraduate career.
- This procedure does not apply to graduate students or to students pursuing a second undergraduate degree.
- "Renewed" courses do not count toward the total hours required for graduation.
- Petition is made to the dean of the student's major college or school.
